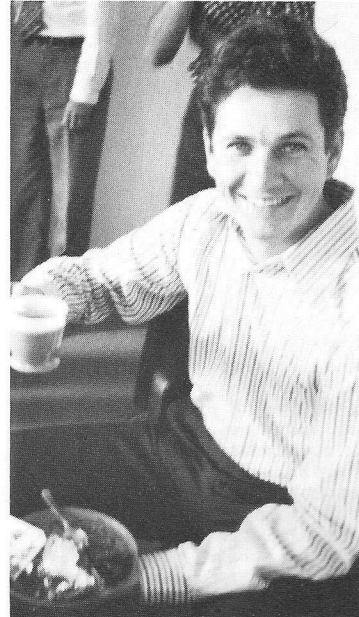
New 10-year Teks from Switzerland are Engelbert Gisler, Peter Kubli and Trudy Lienhard.
