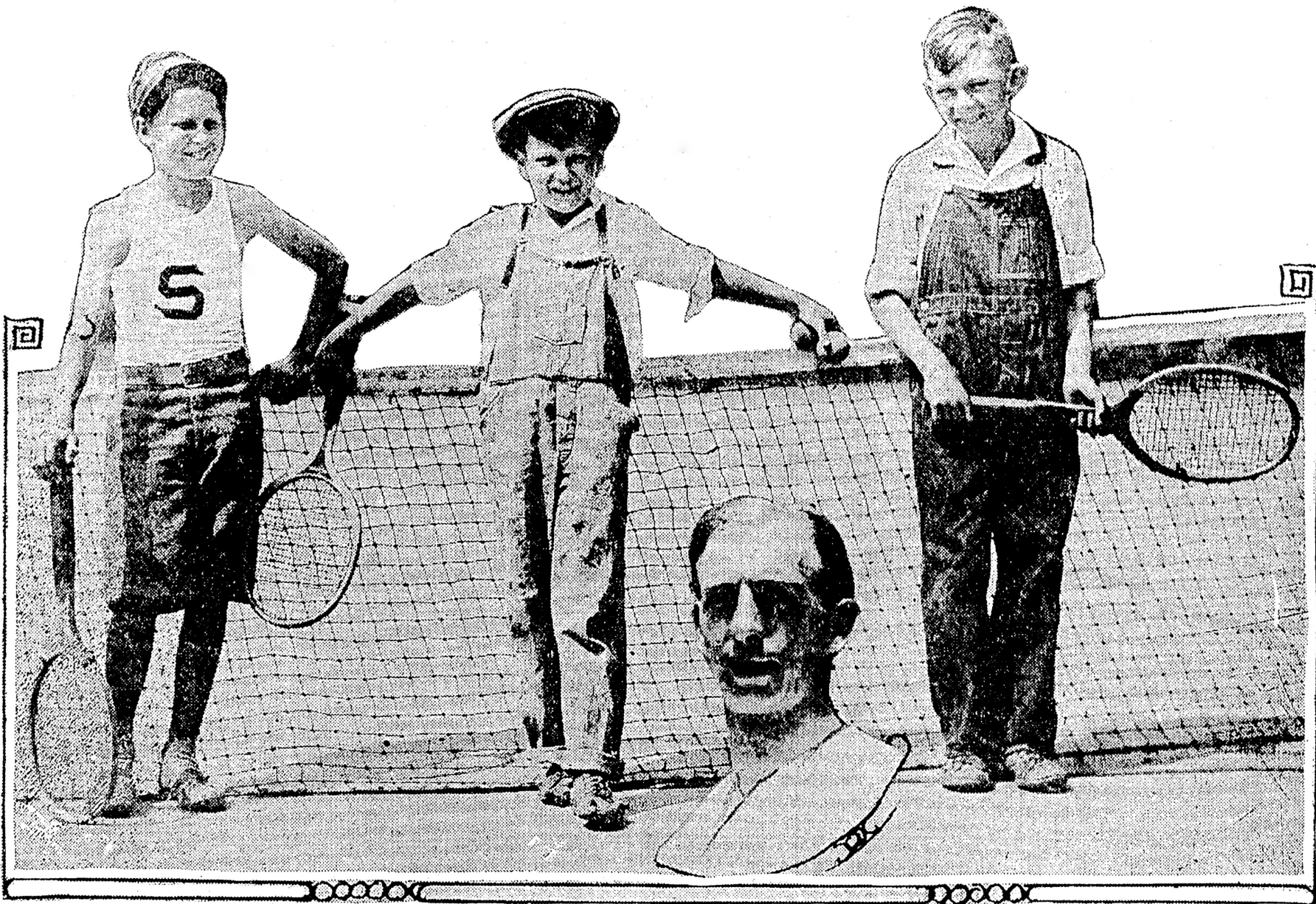


EVEN BILL TILDEN'S SHOES MIGHT FIT THESE YOUNG NET STARS SOME DAY
