

TICKET-- You must have your ticket to enter the event.



Tektronix is proud to welcome legendary Motown singer/songwriter Smokey Robinson as the star musical guest for "A Night of 8,000 Stars."

As one of the primary forces behind the Motown Sound, Smokey and his group, The Miracles, led the charts with such classic tracks as "I Second that Emotion," "Tears of a Clown," and "Shop Around." His impressive song writing credits include The Temptations' "Get Ready," and "My Girl," and Marvin Gaye's "I'll be Doggone." As a solo artist, he has continued to score with such hits as "Cruisin," "Being With You," "Two Heartbeats," and, "Just to See Her." In 1987, he was inducted into the Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame.

Smokey will perform his biggest hits, as well as a medley of The Temptations' songs he helped make famous. Touring with an exciting 22-member band, this private concert promises to be a highlight of the Oregon event on August 10.

CO-STARRING COMEDIAN PAT HAZELL

Our emcee for a "Night of 8,000 Stars" is hot new comedian Pat Hazell. After a successful stint warming up audiences for "Seinfeld," Hazell is on the verge of becoming a star in his own right.

Formerly a magician on the Los Angeles circuit, Hazell made the transition to stand-up comedy at the urging of fellow comics and professional peers in the mid-80s. His lively style of finding the amusing in the mundane made him the perfect host for the "Seinfeld" audiences. His first play, "Bunk Bed," is being developed as a sitcom for NBC, with Hazell starring. Watch for it as a mid-season replacement next February.
